

AB: Arabic

AB 111 — Elementary Arabic 1

3 credits; 2 lecture and 2 lab hours

This introductory course enables students with no background in Arabic to communicate with Arabic-speaking people. The basic skills of speaking, reading, and writing in Arabic are established and the cultures where Arabic is spoken are introduced. Teacher-instructed laboratory sessions reinforce skills learned in the classroom. (G8: Foreign Language).

AB 112 — Arabic II

3 credits; 2 lecture and 2 lab hours

Students expand upon the skills established in Arabic I and continue to study the cultures where Arabic is spoken. Teacher-instructed multimedia language laboratory sessions reinforce skills learned in the classroom.

Prerequisite(s): AB 111.
